The Definition

Homework Assistance-aiding children with assignments they are required to complete outside of class which reinforce skills/concepts taught by the classroom teacher(s) during the regular school day.



The Goal

G-to develop an academic enhancement program with a foundation in character development which will incorporate the use of technology to virtually connect and access information to facilitate a global education program. This program will also include mandatory parental involvement and regularly scheduled family activities.



The Objective

O-to pilot the Homework Assistance Program in the offices of ICB and/or a local library with a select group of students from neighboring Miami-Dade public schools.



The Method

M- Three days a week (M-W), 2 hours per day provide homework assistance to students in the areas of reading, language arts, mathematics and character education.



The Attitude


A-caring, sharing, loving (mentorship), trust, honor and respect.
