

He That Is Spiritual Judgeth all Things and Can Be Judged of No Man

Much mercy, a sign of the New Day Ministry, has been extended to us again just as much mercy was unto David whose actions of killing Bathsheba's husband warranted his death. The Lord continues to unfold the duty of His people, which is to decrease and allow the Christ spirit to increase until we are totally consumed by that spirit. In John 14:7-9, the disciples desired that Jesus show them the Father. Jesus answered, *"Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father;"* Jesus could truthfully speak these words because just as his Father is Spirit, so is he; and because of this likeness the two can be compared as shown in 1 Cor 2:13- 15.

13 Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

14 But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

15 But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man.

In order to compare two things, they must be of the same kind or type. In this case Spirit to spirit.

We are spiritual because we have been spirited by the Christ of God. A natural man is every man born of flesh and blood. The natural man cannot know the things of God. It takes one who is spiritual to reveal spiritual things, after which the soul can come into alignment with Christ. Once in alignment, one is then spiritual and can be compared because it is Spirit to spirit being paralleled. When our whole heart is given unto God, we walk uprightly, and God testifies concerning us, then we are that spiritual one who can be judged of no man. We then have the same testimony as did Jesus, "when you have seen me, you have seen the Father." This declaration of who we are is not to be broadcast to all. Rather, it must be revealed in wisdom to those whose hearts the Father has prepared to receive Christ.

God has called us to judge – to judge ourselves, to judge angels, and to know there is only one righteous judge – God. As God has revealed by way of His Christ that The Ellison Model is The Christ Model, he has given a greater revelation. TEM is The God Model. By way of the model, we are brought to be the very image and likeness of God. John 1:1 helps us understand the oneness of God and Christ.

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

We have been given the tool by which to judge which is TEM. The question for judging is, "are you TEM?" We overcome by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of our testimony, (Rev. 12:11). In our consumed state, the old man no longer has a testimony, but the new man within testimony is of the one who has spirited us -- Christ in us, our hope of glory.
