- Written Communication

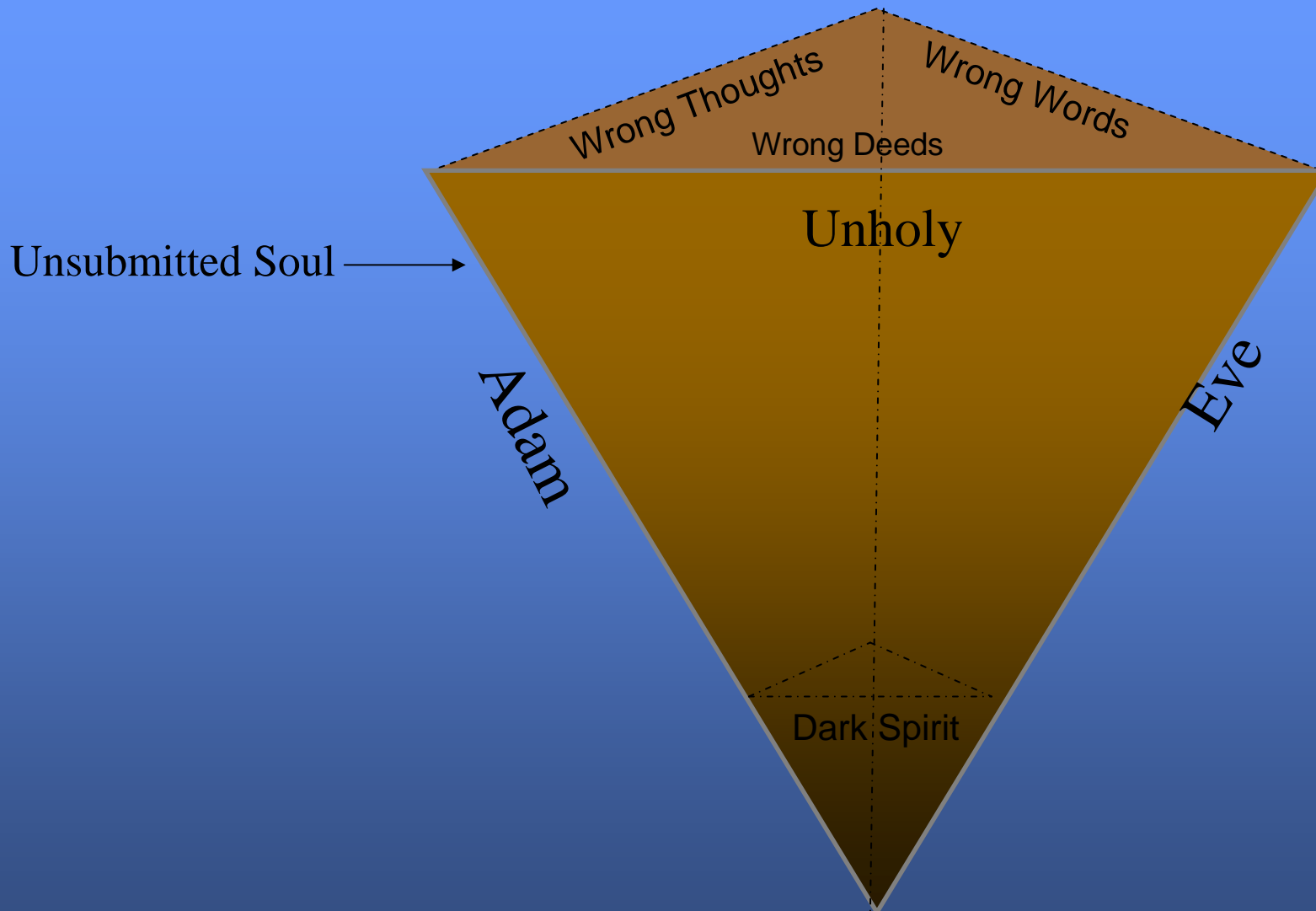
