- To build inclusive community showing how Spiritual Anointing can eclipse Natural Anointing through an Ellison Model demonstration project involving restoring the Garden of Eden

- **Objective**

- To establish a Garden of Eden on Grand Bahama Island
- Show relationship between the natural Garden of Eden and the Spiritual Garden of Eden

Method and Attitude



- **Method**

- A seven week Ellison Model project culminating in the unveiling of the Garden of Eden, Grand Bahama Community Fest and Law of Natural Anointing Symposium
- This project will use mentor/mentee relationships to accomplish physical tasks necessary to develop the property and Garden. All work should be done within the mentor/mentee relationship

- **Attitude**

- Obedience is better than sacrifice
- Caring, Sharing, and Loving, Trust, Honor, and Respect

Ellison Model Project Leading up to Law of Natural Anointing Symposium & Community Fest



- **Six week undertaking**
- **Each house ministry will be involved in aspects of the work**
- **Timeline: October 16, 2009 - November 20, 2009**
- **Each house ministry will send representatives to Grand Bahama one weekend between October 16 – November 20, 2009**
- **Law of Natural Anointing Symposium November 26-28**
- **Community Fest- Saturday, November 28, 2009**

Law of Natural Anointing Symposium



- **Symposium including the Community Fest will be developed at a later date after inputs from The Grand Bahama Community Builder's Club have been received including the topics House Ministries will present during their visit to Freeport.**

Community Fest



- **Saturday, November 28, 2009**
- **Part of the Law of Natural Anointing Symposium. All day festive outdoor event held in the Garden**
- **Serves as unveiling of Garden and invitation will go out to the community at large**
- **Will involve tents, vendors and merchandise, short teachings, interactive events, live entertainment, concert headlined by Seven Steps, and DJs**

Six Weeks Leading Up to Community Fest



- **Each house ministry will be responsible for specific aspects of the physical work**
- **These include**
 - Remove Rocks and Weeds (Land Clearance) from the Garden (D. Ritchey and Munroe) – Breaking up the Fallow Ground and laying a foundation
 - Native Plants Id. Purchase and Planting (Ellison) – identifying those things that are lawful and planting a good seed
 - Build two Gazebos in Garden (Roundtree and A. Williams) -- center of community, a second chance of “making it right”, binding of spirit and soul
 - Develop and Implement Community Fest (O. Ritchey)
 - Develop Marketing Strategy to Witness to the Community and Implement it (D. Hunt Jr. and Munroe)
 - Cleaning, Fix up and General Maintaining (All)

Seven Weeks Project



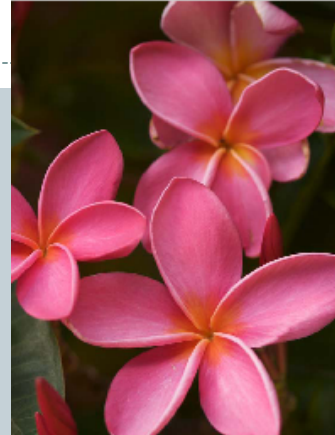
- **Out of the box project. Hands-on project (grab your overalls and prepare to sweat)**

The Garden



- **Children's Garden**
 - Focus on GOMA and 7 step process
 - Children will do research on which indigenous plants are appropriate for planting
- **General Garden (Marriage Garden)**
 - Consider contacting Dept of Agriculture, Port Authority and other community groups to lend/donate equipment/assistance in completing the project

Teachings over the Course of Six Weeks



- Each House Ministry that sends representatives to Grand Bahama will be expected to deliver a teaching relating to the Law of Natural Anointing
- The topics will serve as a precursor to the Law of Natural Anointing Symposium where local community based leaders will be asked to participate
- Sample Topics include:
 - The Significance of the Restoration of the Garden of Eden
 - Natural versus Spiritual Anointing – the role of the conscience
 - Obedience is better than sacrifice – giving in is better than giving up

Headliners and Sponsors



- This project is being spearheaded by the Grand Bahama Community Builder's Club
- The various Community Builder's Clubs of South Florida will lend assistance
- This is not a Church project, but rather, a community building project and should be marketed as such – churches and other community based groups will be invited to participate
- The marketing group will need to garner community support and publicize Community Fest

Fundraising



- Each House Ministry should raise \$5,000 by year end to contribute to this project
- Fundraising projects should not be designed to reach into the pockets of individuals within the house ministries to raise funds. External funds should be sought.
- Examples of Creative Ideas:
 - Adult Socials
 - Children Socials
 - Dance classes
 - Progressive Dinners (pay a fee to have different dinner courses at different homes in close proximity to one another)
 - Fashion Show

House Ministries' Roles



- Pastors of the house ministries will serve as mentors and should designate a person who will serve as project coordinators
- The project coordinators will meet each Thursday at 7:00pm at Dr. Hunt's house with the South Florida Community Builders Steering Committee (the Sunday group that meets at Dr. Hunt's house)

Questions that Each Pastor Should Answer



- **Logistics**

- Who will be going to Freeport on the designated weekend
- Who will make flight arrangements and when
- How will costs be paid for
- Transportation (departure and arrival)
- Lodging
- Meals
- Shipping of materials, if necessary.
